Recommendation from the District Dues/Fees for 2022 Floor Committee

- **Subject:** to continue the due/fee of \$50 per called worker into the next convention and appoint an *ad hoc* committee to study the growing expenses of the Western Wisconsin District in the care of called workers.
- Whereas (1): The Western Wisconsin District (WWD) dues have not been changed or analyzed in decades, and
- Whereas (2): the costs of doing all WWD business and correspondence will continue go up with inflation, and
- Whereas (3): the use of WWD dues is also the primary source for called worker care in the MAP program, and
- Whereas (4): the cost of each MAP program session is increasing to \$85 this year along with an ever-increasing use of the WWD MAP sessions by called workers, therefore be it
- Resolved (1): that the WWD convention approve the recommended one time due/fee of \$50 for each male called worker to continue until the next convention, and be it further
- Resolved (2): that the WWD appoint an *ad hoc* committee to further study the issue of the rising costs to the district; be it further
- Resolved (3): that the newly appointed Dues/ Fees *ad hoc* committee follow the work of the circuit pastor recommendation and that the soon to be appointed *ad hoc* committee "consider proactive approaches to care for the mental health needs of our district's called workers and their families", be it finally
- Resolved (4): that the Dues/Fees *ad hoc* committee prepare a detailed report on finances and a proactive schedule to cover the rising cost of convention business and the care of the WWD called workers through the MAP program.
