Since 2005, 316NOW has proclaimed *grace across China* by teaching church leaders there sound Bible interpretation, Christian theology, and practice. Our goal is to work with sister WELS organizations to raise up a Confessional Lutheran movement in China.



Challenges

Christianity in China faces multiple challenges.

- Communism: China's government impedes any religious faith. The government insists on increasing control of Christianity and its message.
- Religion: Forty percent of Chinese are Buddhists, Hindus, Muslims, or folk religion adherents. Fifty percent claim no religion.
- Culture: Over 1.2 billion souls in China (90%) are not Christians. Consequently, Chinese morals, goals, and world view are often at odds with Christian values and lifestyles.
- Church: The Christian Church is divided between the official church (the Three-Self Church) and independent churches. Their leadership is inadequately trained. They emphasize law over gospel.

Our ministry

316NOW trains Confessional Lutheran leaders in China through our online Bible institute.

We invite any church leader to take our courses in Bible interpretation, theology, and pastoral practice. From our student body, we raise up leaders who will become standard bearers for Confessional Lutheranism.

Our Bible institute professors are all WELS and ELS pastors. We coordinate our work with the WELS ministries in China.
